Trevor Mast was a legend of the Australian wine scene. Among his many accomplishments, he is most revered as a pioneer of cool climate Shiraz. The Mast Shiraz is our tribute to his memory, recognising his role in establishing the reputation of Mount Langi Ghiran.

Thanks to his foresight, our vineyards showcase the ultimate expression of cool climate Shiraz.

### TASTING NOTE

**Colour:** Deep crimson.

**Nose:** Bright red fruits and cherries on the nose, vanilla and spice.

**Palate:** Expansive palate with the red fruit character complimented by notes of black cherry, blackberry, cedar and cinnamon.

**Cellar:** 15-20 years.

### VINEYARD DETAILS

**Region:** Grampians

**Vineyards:** Mount Langi Estate – House Block 4, Contour, Old Block

**Vine age:** Average 25 years

**Harvest date:** April 2019

**Harvest method:** 90% Hand picked, 10% Machine

### WINEMAKING NOTE

**Fermentation method:** Small open top fermenters. 50% Whole berry, 50% whole bunch. A mixture of plunging and pump-overs were used during fermentation.

An average of 2-3 weeks total time on skins. Natural yeasts were used and once ferment was complete the wines were pressed to tank to settle overnight and then transferred to barrels to complete MLF.

**Barrel Origin:** 100% French oak barriques.

**Barrel Age:** 25% new.

**Time in Barrel:** 18 month barrel maturation
